The approximate quantities of work to be bid upon are described as follows:

The work includes installation of a new packaged headworks system, installation of a new flow meter vault, replacement of one (1) oxidation ditch rotor with new cover, replacement of clarification equipment, replacement of the existing RAS pump and associated valves, grinder pump station rehabilitation, new controls on the sludge holding tank equipment, new gable roof and new HVAC system. The work also includes Pyles Avenue Grinder Pump Station Improvements, Lift Station #1 "Bowers" Improvements and all necessary site work, yard piping, temporary bypass pumping, electrical, mechanical and all other associated appurtenances for a complete operable system.

The Work will be substantially completed within <u>300</u> calendar days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run, and completed and ready for final payment within <u>330</u> days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run. Liquidated damages shall be <u>\$1,000.00</u> per day.

Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to City of Mannington, in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the base bid.
