### ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the construction of the EQ Basin Project-Contract #2 Equalization Tank will be received by the City of Mount Hope, located at 609 Main Street, Mount Hope, Fayette County, West Virginia until **2:00 PM** local time on February 19, 2019, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The approximate quantities of work to be bid upon are described as follows:

1. The work consists of the construction of a 2 MG Equalization Tank including: mobilization/demobilization; site clearing; site work; access road; site piping; fence and gate; and all necessary appurtenances to complete the Work.

The Work will be substantially completed within 180 calendar days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run, and completed and ready for final payment within 210 days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run. Liquidated damages shall be \$1,000 per day.

Envelope No. 2 labeled "Bid Proposal" shall also be placed inside of Envelope #1.

Envelope No. 1 will be opened first and the Bid Opening Requirement items checked for compliance as outlined on the Bid Opening Checklist on page BOR - 1 of these contract documents. If such documents are found to be in order, Envelope No. 2 "Bid Proposal", will then be opened and will be publicly read aloud. If the documents required to be contained in Envelope No. 1 are not in order, Envelope No. 2 "Bid Proposal" will not be opened and the Bid will be considered non-responsive and will be returned to the Bidder.

A bidder may not withdraw his bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date set for the opening of bids.

# NOTICE OF FEDERAL WAGE REQUIREMENTS

Contractors are required to comply with all laws pertaining to the federal wage rates issued in accordance with the Davis Bacon Act. The Contractor will be required to pay the higher of the state or federal wage rates appropriate for each work classification.

All Bidders are required to have a West Virginia Contractor's License per Section §21-11-11 of the West Virginia Code.

Contractor is required to provide the Drug Free Workplace Certification in accordance with WV Code 21-1D-5.

A Bidder may not withdraw his Bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date set for the opening of Bids.

Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or Bid Bond payable to the City of Mount Hope for an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the Total Bid.

Bidders must hold a current West Virginia contractor's license on the date of Bid Opening.

Bids received after the scheduled closing time for the reception of Bids will be returned unopened to the Bidders.

The City of Mount Hope reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
