ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the construction of Contract #1 – Cranberry Ridge & Waterline Extension will be received, by Camden-on-Gauley Water Works at the offices of The Thrasher Group, Inc. located at 300 Association Drive, Charleston, West Virginia, until **2:00 p.m.** local time on **October 29, 2020**. Immediately following the scheduled closing time for the reception of Bids, all proposals which have been submitted in accordance with the conditions of the Contract Documents will be publicly opened and read aloud through live-stream, as social distancing guidelines will be followed. A link for the live-stream of the Bid Opening will be provided via Addendum.

The approximate quantities of work to be bid upon are described as follows:

Gate Valve w/ Box & Lid; 13 EA 4” M.J.T. Gate Valve w/ Box & Lid; 5 EA Air Release Valve; 6 EA 2” Post Flushing Hydrant; 2 EA Tie-In to Existing 6” Water Line; 100 LF WVDOH Type “B” Trench Repair; 16,000 LF WVDOH Type “C” Trench Repair; 2,000 LF WVDOH Rock Lined Ditch; 200 LF Asphalt Driveway Repair; 1,500 LF Gravel Driveway Repair; 25 LF Concrete Walkway Repair; 1 LS Booster Station; 12,500 LF WVDOH Inspection Fee Allowance; 6,100 LF Reclamation of Disturbed Area and 1LS Additive Alternate No. 1.

The Work will be substantially completed within 180 calendar days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run, and completed and ready for final payment within 210 days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run. Liquidated damages shall be \$1,000 per day.

A two envelope system will be used.

Envelope No. 1 must have the following information presented on the front:

Envelope No. 2 labeled “Bid Proposal” shall also be placed inside of Envelope #1.

Envelope No. 1 will be opened first and the Bid Opening Requirement items checked for compliance as outlined on the Bid Opening Checklist on page BOR - 1 of these contract documents. If such documents are found to be in order, Envelope No. 2 “Bid Proposal”, will then be opened and will be publicly read aloud. If the documents required to be contained in Envelope No. 1 are not in order, Envelope No. 2 “Bid Proposal” will not be opened and the Bid will be considered non-responsive and will be returned to the Bidder.

US ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS ENVIRONMENTAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT PROVISIONS

This construction of this project will be funded in part with funds made available from the Federal Government through the US Army Corps of Engineers Section 340 program. Bidders must comply with all applicable laws and regulations for construction projects receiving Federal

aid including, but not limited to, the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, and the Davis-Bacon Act as amended.

A bidder may not withdraw his bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date set for the opening of bids.

Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to Camden-on-Gauley Water Works in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the base bid.

Contractor is required to provide the Drug Free Workplace Certification in accordance with WV Code 21-1D-5.

All Bidders are required to have a West Virginia Contractor's License per Section §21-11-11 of the West Virginia Code.

Bids received after the scheduled closing time for the reception of bids will be returned unopened to the bidders.

The Camden on Gauley Water Works reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
