A. <u>GENERAL</u>

2. SBA Form 403-B Complete List of Subcontractors and Equipment /Materials Suppliers has been corrected on page 2 to read "*Calhoun-Gilmer Career Center Annex Renovations.*" on the project line.

B. <u>SPECIFICATIONS</u>

1. SECTION 012300 – ALTERNATES Article 3.1.C REVISE TO READ: Polish existing concrete floors in Annex A in lieu of base bid sealed concrete and LVT floor covering.

D. <u>QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES</u>

QUESTION

1. Alternate #1 – Will each door be 2'-10" wide?

RESPONSE

Yes. Contractor to field verify existing conditions prior to commencing the work.

QUESTION

2. Do you want glass in the transom of Door 101 – If so can you tell us what type?

RESPONSE

Glass Type GL-#2: Low-E-coated, tinted insulating glass.

- 1. Basis-of-Design Product: Solarban 60(3) + Match existing tint.
- 2. Overall Unit Thickness: 1 inch (25 mm).
- 3. Minimum Thickness of Each Glass Lite: 6 mm.
- 4. Outdoor Lite: Tinted fully tempered float glass.
- 5. Tint Color: Match existing tint.
- 6. Interspace Content: Air.
- 7. Indoor Lite: Clear fully tempered float glass.
- 8. Low-E Coating: Pyrolytic or sputtered on second or third surface.
- 9. Safety glazing required.

3. Could you tell us what hardware to price for the bid? Or give an allowance to put in bid until they owner decides?

RESPONSE

Falcon F Series

4. Confirm that everything is to be painted. There is a paint spec but the drawing doesn't say anything about painting.

RESPONSE

All walls to receive new paint.

QUESTION

5. Confirm owner will remove all items from the wall that is not listed on drawings.

RESPONSE

Owner will remove all items from the walls prior to construction.

QUESTION

6. Confirm owner will have all contents removed from the building.

RESPONSE

Owner will remove contents from the building prior to construction.

1. Storage 100 and 100 A shall be sealed concrete in base bid.

For each category of work that requires a Subcontractor or Equipment / Materials Supplier that exceeds a value of \$25,000, the Proposer shall clearly and legibly list each Category of Work and the corresponding Subcontractor and Equipment/Materials Supplier's name and valid Contractor license number. If no Subcontractors are proposed to be used, indicate on the form by writing "No Subcontractors Proposed." DO NOT list multiple Subcontractor than the Subcontractor listed on SBA Form 403-A that was provided at the time of bid.

The Proposing Contractor is responsible for selecting Equipment/Materials Suppliers for this project. However, the Owner, Architect/Engineer and/or School Building Authority may disqualify a proposed Subcontractor or Equipment/Materials Suppliers if the Subcontractor or Equipment/Materials Suppliers is on probationary status.

1.1 SUMMARY

1.2 DEFINITIONS

- A. Alternate: An amount proposed by bidders and stated on the Bid Form for certain work defined in the bidding requirements that may be added to or deducted from the base bid amount if the Owner decides to accept a corresponding change either in the amount of construction to be completed or in the products, materials, equipment, systems, or installation methods described in the Contract Documents.
 - 1. Alternates described in this Section are part of the Work only if enumerated in the Agreement.
 - 2. The cost or credit for each alternate is the net addition to or deduction from the Contract Sum to incorporate alternates into the Work. No other adjustments are made to the Contract Sum.

1.3 PROCEDURES

- A. Coordination: Revise or adjust affected adjacent work as necessary to completely integrate work of the alternate into Project.
 - 1. Include as part of each alternate, miscellaneous devices, accessory objects, and similar items incidental to or required for a complete installation whether or not indicated as part of alternate.
- B. Execute accepted alternates under the same conditions as other work of the Contract.
- C. Schedule: A schedule of alternates is included at the end of this Section. Specification Sections referenced in schedule contain requirements for materials necessary to achieve the work described under each alternate.
