BENEDUM AIRPORT AUTHORITY HARRISON COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA MHI BUILDING RENOVATIONS THRASHER PROJECT #030-10119

Sealed Bids for Contract MHI Building Renovations will be received by the Benedum Airport Authority, 2000 Aviation Way, Bridgeport, Harrison County, West Virginia, **until 2:00 p.m., L.P.T., on Thursday January 20, 2022**, for furnishing labor and materials and performing all Work set forth in the Contract Documents prepared by The Thrasher Group, Inc. Immediately following the scheduled closing time for the reception of Bids, all proposals which have been submitted in accordance with the conditions of the Contract Documents will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The approximate quantities of Work to be Bid upon is as described as follows:

Renovation of the building HVAC and Fire Alarm systems. The building is Type II Non-combustible construction containing aircraft hangars, administrative offices, and support facilities. The systems to be renovated support approximately 149,000 SF. Renovations consist of: Complete replacement of the existing HVAC system including removal of the existing natural gas fired boilers and pumps, water source heat pumps, make up air water source heat pump handlers, cooling tower, heating/ventilation units, associated piping and controls as well as selective demolition and new ceilings, in areas of the Work. The new system will consist of ducted VRF air handlers, VRF cassette units, a new energy recovery unit is to be installed in the existing mechanical room. New gas radiant heaters will be provided for service bays I, II, III, and IV. A new control system will provide central as well as individual unit control of space temperature and equipment operation. Fire Alarm detection and signaling devices will be upgraded and replaced.

The Work will be substantially completed within 210 calendar days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run, and completed and ready for final payment within 240 days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run. Liquidated damages shall be \$500 per day.

A two envelope system will be used.

Envelope No. 1 must have the following information presented on the front:

Name and address of Bidder
Bid on Contract – MHI Building Renovations
Received by the Benedum Airport Authority

Envelope No. 2 labeled “Bid Proposal” shall also be placed inside of Envelope #1.

Envelope No. 1 will be opened first and the Bid Opening Requirement items checked for compliance as outlined on the Bid Opening Checklist on page BOR - 1 of these contract documents. If such documents are found to be in order, Envelope No. 2 “Bid Proposal”, will then be opened and will be publicly read aloud. If the documents required to be contained in Envelope No. 1 are not in order, Envelope No. 2 “Bid Proposal” will not be opened and the Bid will be considered non-responsive and will be returned to the Bidder.

A bidder may not withdraw his bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date set for the opening of bids.

Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to Benedum Airport Authority in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the base bid.

Contractor is required to provide the Drug Free Workplace Certification in accordance with WV Code 21-1D-5.

All Bidders are required to have a West Virginia Contractor’s License per Section §21-11-11 of the West Virginia Code.

Bids received after the scheduled closing time for the reception of bids will be returned unopened to the bidders.

The Benedum Airport Authority reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

A pre-bid conference will be held at **10:00 a.m.** local time on **January 5th, 2022** at the Benedum Airport Authority located at 2000 Aviation Way, Bridgeport, WV 26330. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory.
