General Notice

Mason County Public Service District (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Ashton Water Treatment Plant Improvements Project
Thrasher Project #010-10214

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the Mason County Public Service District Office located at 101 Camden Avenue, Point Pleasant, Mason County, WV 25550, until Tuesday, July 26, 2022, at 2:00 pm local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

To provide all labor, materials, equipment, and appurtenances necessary to rehabilitate the existing backwash filter vessels, piping, and pumps, including but not limited to: the modification of the existing underdrain system to drill out (56) 2-1/16" threaded holes in each pressure filter and include (56) 3" stainless steel wedge wire nozzles in each pressure filter, the rehabilitation of the coating system in the existing filter vessels, the removal and replacement of the existing air scour piping with stainless steel air scour piping, the removal of the existing filter media support gravel and replacement of 8" of new support gravel, the removal and replacement of the existing filter media with 36" of Layne Ox filter media, and the modification of the existing backwash pump to remove the existing 8.75" impeller and replace with a 9.60" impeller.

The Work will be substantially completed within 180 calendar days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run, and completed and ready for final payment within 270 days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run. Liquidated damages shall be \$1,000 per day.

A two envelope system will be used.

Envelope No. 1 must have the following information presented on the front:

Name and address of Bidder
Bid on – Ashton Water Treatment Plant Improvements Project
Received by the Mason County Public Service District

Envelope No. 2 labeled "Bid Proposal" shall also be placed inside of Envelope #1.

Envelope No. 1 will be opened first and the Bid Opening Requirement items checked for compliance as outlined on the Bid Opening Checklist on page BOR - 1 of these contract documents. If such documents are found to be in order, Envelope No. 2 "Bid Proposal", will then be opened and will be publicly read aloud. If the documents required to be contained in Envelope No. 1 are not in order, Envelope No. 2 "Bid Proposal" will not be opened and the Bid will be considered non-responsive and will be returned to the Bidder.

A bidder may not withdraw his bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date set for the opening of bids.

Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to Mason County Public Service District in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the base bid.

Contractor is required to provide the Drug Free Workplace Certification in accordance with WV Code 21-1D-5.

All Bidders are required to have a West Virginia Contractor's License per Section §30-42-12 of the West Virginia Code.

Bids received after the scheduled closing time for the reception of bids will be returned unopened to the bidders.

The Mason County Public Service District reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Pre-bid Conference

A pre-bid conference for the Project will be held on **Wednesday, June 29, 2022 at 10:00 am** at the **Ashton Water Treatment Plant** located in Mercers Bottom, West Virginia near the intersection of Ohio River Road (WV Route 2) and Jerrys Run Road (County Route 37) in Mason County, West Virginia. The approximate latitude and longitude of the WTP are 38° 38' 33" N by 82° 09' 46" W. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is encouraged but not required.
