General Notice

Monongahela Valley Association of Health Center (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

**MVA Clinic H8F Renovations

And

**MVA Clinic C8E Renovations

Bids for the construction of the Project(s) will be received at the **MVA Clinic** located at **1322 Locust Ave. Fairmont**, until **Wednesday, July 20, 2022 at 2:00 p.m.** local time. At that time the Bids received will be **privately** opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

Contract 1: Interior renovation of limited areas of the second floor of the Locust Avenue MVA Clinic Building. The building is a Business Occupancy of Type II Non-combustible construction containing outpatient medical clinic, administrative and support facilities. The areas to be renovated encompass approximately 7,700 SF. Renovations consist of selective demolition, new ceilings, finishes, casework, lighting/power, plumbing and other Work indicated in the Contract Documents.

Contract 2: Interior renovation of first floor pharmacy, limited areas of the second floor, metal roof replacement, parking lot repaving, and construction of a new two-story storage building for the MVA Clinic. The existing clinic building is a Business Occupancy of Type II Non-combustible construction containing outpatient medical clinic, administrative and support facilities. The areas to be renovated encompass approximately 3,500 SF in the existing building and 1200 SF of new building construction. Renovations consist of selective demolition, new ceilings, finishes, casework, lighting/power, plumbing, roofing, and other Work indicated in the Contract Documents. Repaving consists of approximately 17,500 SF of parking area. New storage building construction is approximately 1,800 SF of CMU and wood framed construction.

Bids are requested for the following Contract: **MVA Clinic H8F Renovations & MVA Clinic C8E Renovations**

Separate Bids will be received for the following Contracts:

The Work for Contract 1 will be substantially completed within 90 calendar days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run and completed and ready for final payment within 110 days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run. Liquidated damages shall be \$250.00 per day.

The Work for Contract 2 will be substantially completed within 275 calendar days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run and completed and ready for final payment within 300 days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run. Liquidated damages shall be \$250.00 per day.

A two-envelope system will be used.

Envelope No. 1 must have the following information presented on the front:

Name and address of Bidder

Bid on Contract – #1 MVA Clinic H8F Clinic Renovations #2 MVA Clinic C8E Renovations
Received by the MVA Health Center, Inc.

Envelope No. 2 labeled “Bid Proposal” shall also be placed inside of Envelope #1.

Envelope No. 1 will be opened first and the Bid Opening Requirement items checked for compliance as outlined on the Bid Opening Checklist on page BOR - 1 of these contract documents. If such documents are found to be in order, Envelope No. 2 “Bid Proposal”, will then be opened and will be publicly read aloud. If the documents required to be contained in Envelope No. 1 are not in order, Envelope No. 2 “Bid Proposal” will not be opened and the Bid will be considered non-responsive and will be returned to the Bidder.

A bidder may not withdraw his bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date set for the opening of bids.

Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to Monongahela Valley Association of Health Centers in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the base bid.

Contractor is required to provide the Drug Free Workplace Certification in accordance with WV Code 21-1D-5.

All Bidders are required to have a West Virginia Contractor’s License per Section §30-42-12 of the West Virginia Code.

Bids received after the scheduled closing time for the reception of bids will be returned unopened to the bidders.

The Monongahela Valley Association of Health Centers reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
