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## A. GENERAL

1. The **Method of Award** will be a two part evaluation comprised of: **Part I - Qualitative Proposal** (100 points possible), **Part II - Cost Proposal** (100 points possible).

Both Part I and Part II are due on Wednesday, July 20, 2022 by 2:00 p.m. Part I will be opened publicly; and then evaluated and scored privately at the convenience of the Owner prior to opening Part II. All proposers will be notified of Qualitative Proposal scores prior to the opening of Part II.

Part II shall be opened publicly on Wednesday, July 27, 2022 at 2:00 p.m.; and then evaluated and scored privately at the convenience of the Owner.

The award will be based on the total combined score of Part I and Part II.

The Instructions for the Method of Award submission are attached to this addendum.

- 5. Anticipated notice to proceed: Wednesday, August 10, 2022
- 6. Required substantial completion: 275 days after notice to proceed
- 7. Required final completion: 300 days after notice to proceed
- 8. Scoring preference will be given to contractors that can propose a substantial completion date sooner than stated above.
- 9. The owner reserves the right to change the schedule or terminate the entire competition process at any time.

#### **PACKAGE SEQUENCING**

- 1. Package No. 1 "Qualitative Proposals" will be opened publicly and evaluated privately by the technical review committee according to the rating system
- The Qualitative Proposals will be scored as follows: The highest Qualitative Score will be
  assigned a value of 100. The other Qualitative Scores will be assigned values by the following
  formula: Qualitative Score being evaluated divided by the highest Qualitative Score
  multiplied by 100.
- 3. All proposers will be notified of Qualitative Scores. Once the Qualitative Scores are announced, the Cost Proposals will be opened publicly and read aloud. All Proposers will be notified of the time and date of the public Cost Proposal Opening.
- 4. The Cost Proposals will be scored as follows:
  - i. All Cost Proposals will be scored on the total base proposal.
  - ii. It is assumed that the credit for extension of the substantial completion date is to be applied at the Owners discretion **after** the successful Contractor has been determined.
  - iii. Total proposed cost to include all labor, material, professional services, permit and review fees, taxes, insurance and bonds, and all other costs associated with completing the project as determined in the contract documents.
- 5. The lowest Total Proposed Cost will be assigned a Cost Value of 100. The other total proposed costs will be assigned Cost Values by the following formula: The lowest Total Proposed Cost divided by the Total Proposed Cost being evaluated multiplied by 100 equals the Cost Value.
- 6. The Total Value will be determined by adding the Qualitative Value and the Cost Value.

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- 7. The proposal with the highest Total Value will be considered for award.
- 8. Acceptance, Award and Rejection: All proposals will remain subject to acceptance for 90 days after the day of the proposal opening, but the Owner may, at its sole discretion, release any proposal and return the proposal security prior to that date.
  - Owner reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, including without limitation the right to reject any or all nonconforming, nonresponsive, unbalanced, or conditioned proposals.
  - ii. Owner reserves the right to reject the proposal of any proposer if Owner believes that it would not be in the best interest of the project to make an award to that proposer, whether because the proposal is not responsive or fails to meet any other pertinent standard or criteria established by Owner.
  - iii. Owner also reserves the right to waive all informalities not involving price, time, or changes in the work, and to negotiate contract and contract terms with the apparent successful proposer
- Execution of Agreement: When the Owner gives a Notice of Award to the successful proposer, the proposer will be expected to execute the Agreement within 10 days thereafter, and deliver fully executed Payment and Performance bonds and insurance certificates.

#### **EVALUATION**

#### A. THE EVALUATORS

- 1. Evaluation and recommendation will be made by a technical review committee appointed by the Owner for that purpose.
- Owner may conduct such other investigations as Owner deems necessary to assist in the
  evaluation of, and to establish the responsibility, qualifications, and financial ability of
  proposers, proposed design professionals, subcontractors, suppliers, and other individuals
  and entities ability to perform the work in accordance with the Contract Documents.

## **B. SELECTION CRITERIA**

I. Basis of Selection: The successful proposal will be the one that provides the best value to the Owner, based on the best Total Value as calculated using weighted criteria.
