TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

A Pre-Bid Conference was held on Wednesday, July 13, 2022 on the above-referenced project, a copy of the sign in sheet is included in this Addendum. The following are clarifications and responses to questions posed by contractors for the above reference project.

A. <u>GENERAL</u>

1. THE BID FORM HAS BEEN REVISED. YOU MUST USE THE REVISED BID FORM WHEN PREPARING YOUR BID PACKAGE FOR THIS PROJECT.

B. SPECIFICATIONS

None on this addendum.

C. <u>DRAWINGS</u>

- 1. Sht. 02 General Notes: Added item #10 Concrete Curb, Increased quantities for item #'s 03 Asphalt milling, 05 Asphalt Scratch Course, 06 Parking blocks, and changed full depth repair to be 30 SY of new concrete pad.
- 2. Sht. 04 Storm Upgrades: Added hatching and notes illustrating approximate asphalt milling locations. Added location of additional parking blocks and markings.

D. QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES

QUESTION

1. Does the Town have a B&O tax?

RESPONSE

Yes, 1.0 %, however the town will waive for this project. The contractor will be required to obtain a business license in the town at a cost of \$25 for a year.

QUESTION

2. Is there a bid item for concrete curbing?

RESPONSE

Yes, a bid item has been included for the proposed concrete curbing at a LF unit bid price.

QUESTION

3. Will the per ton asphalt prices be adjusted to reflect increases in the asphalt index at the time of placing the asphalt?

RESPONSE

No, the goal is to accomplish this project this summer/early fall and therefore, the project will not use any price adjustments or index. Contractor shall estimate according to provide the best price to get the project done with all circumstances considered.

OUESTION

4. The plans only show 6 inlets, but bid quantity shows 7?

RESPONSE

The bid quantities have been revised to only 6 inlets, the seventh structure is a concrete wingwall and it shall be incidental to the LF bid price for the storm pipe.

QUESTION

5. What is the depth of the asphalt milling?

RESPONSE

1 1/2" +/-

E. <u>CLARIFICATIONS</u>

1. The Town has no work restrictions on hours or days. The town hall closes at 4 pm and the Pharmacy/Medical building closes at 5 pm.

1.02 The undersigned Bidder proposes and agrees, if this Bid is accepted, to enter into an Agreement with Owner in the form included in the Bidding Documents to perform all Work as specified or indicated in the Bidding Documents for the prices and within the times indicated in this Bid and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.

ARTICLE 3—BASIS OF BID—LUMP SUM BID AND UNIT PRICES

GENERAL

The Bidder shall take notice of and shall be responsible for any local or state taxes levied and applicable, and the cost for the same shall be included as part of the submitted Bid.

The total Bid cost stated includes a complete operating installation including furnishing and installation of any and all changes or additions in plans, piping, mechanical work, additional electrical work, accessories, controls, etc. necessary to accommodate alternative equipment systems or materials used in construction.

BID PROPOSAL

The Bidder agrees to perform all required Work described in the detailed Specifications and as shown on the Plans for the complete construction and placing in satisfactory operation the **Parking Lot Paving**. The Project "Sequence of Construction" has been detailed in the Drawings and Specification Division 1, Project Summary, Section 011000. The Bidder agrees to perform all the Work proposed for the total of the following Bid prices.

If such bids exceeds such amount, the owner may reject all bids.

ARTICLE 4—TIME OF COMPLETION

- 4.01 Bidder agrees that the Work will be substantially complete and will be completed and ready for final payment in accordance with Paragraph 15.06 of the General Conditions on or before the dates or within the number of calendar days indicated in the Agreement.
- 4.02 Bidder accepts the provisions of the Agreement as to liquidated damages.

ARTICLE 6—BIDDER'S REPRESENTATIONS AND CERTIFICATIONS

- 6.01 Bidder's Representations
 - A. In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents the following:
 - 1. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, including Addenda.
 - 2. Bidder has visited the Site, conducted a thorough visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
 - 3. Bidder is familiar with all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
 - 4. Bidder has carefully studied the reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and the drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface

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or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, with respect to the Technical Data in such reports and drawings.

- 5. Bidder has carefully studied the reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
- 6. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and the Technical Data identified in the Supplementary Conditions or by definition, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and Technical Data on (a) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (b) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder, if selected as Contractor; and (c) Bidder's (Contractor's) safety precautions and programs.
- 7. Based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, Bidder agrees that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the performance of the Work at the Contract Price, within the Contract Times, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Contract.
- 8. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- 9. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and of discrepancies between Site conditions and the Contract Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Contractor.
- 10. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for performance and furnishing of the Work.
- 11. The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.

- 3. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding.
- 4. Bidder has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 8.02.A:
 - a. Corrupt practice means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process.
 - b. Fraudulent practice means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish bid prices at

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artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition.

- c. Collusive practice means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels.
- d. Coercive practice means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the execution of the Contract.

- 1. THE GOVERNING SPECIFICATIONS FOR THIS PROJECT WILL BE THE WEST VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS, ROADS AND BRIDGES, ADOPTED 2017, SUPPLEMENTAL SPECIFICATIONS DATED JANUARY 1, 2022, STANDARD DETAILS VOLUME I DATED JANUARY 1, 2000, VOLUME II DATED JANUARY 1, 1994, AND THE REVISED STANDARD DETAILS. - 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL LOCATE AND PROTECT EXISTING UTILITIES AND FACILITIES FROM DAMAGE BY EQUIPMENT OR PERSONNEL. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT ALL UTILITY AND FACILITY AGENCIES FOR FIELD MARKING PRIOR TO BEGINNING CONSTRUCTION INCLUDING MISS UTILITY. THE LOCATIONS OF EXISTING UNDERGROUND UTILITIES ARE SHOWN IN AN APPROXIMATE WAY ONLY AND HAVE NOT BEEN INDEPENDENTLY VERIFIED BY THE OWNER OR ITS REPRESENTATIVE. ANY UTILITIES OR FACILITIES DAMAGED DURING THE PROJECT BY THE CONTRACTOR OR EQUIPMENT SHALL BE PROMPTLY REPAIRED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE. HAND DIGGING TO PROTECT UTILITIES FROM DAMAGE SHOULD BE ANTICIPATED.
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL HAVE ON THE SITE AT ALL TIMES A COMPETENT SUPERINTENDENT CAPABLE OF READING AND UNDERSTANDING THE CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS AND THOROUGHLY EXPERIENCED IN THE TYPE OF WORK BEING PERFORMED, AND SHALL BE ABLE TO COORDINATE WITH THE ENGINEER.
- 4. THE CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS REPRESENT THE PROPOSED LINES, GRADES, AND APPURTENANCE TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTEND OF THE SCOPE OF WORK. CERTAIN INCIDENTAL ITEMS TO COMPLETE THE SCOPE OF WORK MAY NOT BE SHOWN.
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING A VALID WEST VIRGINIA GENERAL CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE AND PAYING ALL APPLICABLE STATE AND LOCAL TAXES.
- 6. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR VERIFICATION OF ALL PLAN AND ELEVATION DIMENSIONS OF THE VARIOUS WORK ITEMS ON THIS PROJECT.
- 7. IN THE EVENT AN ERROR WITH THE PLANS SEEMS APPARENT, THE MATTER MUST BE TAKEN UP WITH THE ENGINEER FOR CAREFUL REVIEW BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH CONSTRUCTION.
- 8. THE OWNER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CONTRACT TO AND PERFORM OTHER OR ADDITIONAL WORK ADJACENT TO AND WITHIN THE WORK AREA COVERED BY THIS CONTRACT. WHEN SEPARATE CONTRACTS ARE LET WITHIN THE LIMITS OF ANY ONE PROJECT, EACH CONTRACTOR SHALL CONDUCT THEIR WORK SO AS NOT TO INTERFERE WITH OR HINDER THE PROGRESS OR THE COMPLETION OF THE WORK BEING COMPLETED BY OTHER CONTRACTORS. THE CONTRACTORS WORKING ON THE SAME PROJECT SHALL COOPERATE WITH EACH OTHER AS ORDERED BY THE OWNER AND/OR ENGINEER.
- . ALL DISTURBED AREAS, INCLUDING THE CONTRACTORS STAGING AREA, GRADING LIMITS, WASTE AREAS, ETC. SHALL BE RESTORED TO A SMOOTH LINE AND GRADE WITH POSITIVE DRAINAGE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SEED AND MULCH ALL DISTURBED AREAS. THERE WILL BE NO MEASUREMENT FOR PAYMENT OF SEEDING.
- 10. ALL BROKEN CONCRETE & ASPHALT, TRASH, RUBBISH, ORGANICS, & OTHER UNSUITABLE MATERIAL SHALL BE DISPOSED OF OFF SITE BY THE CONTRACTOR.
- 11. ALL LOOSE MATERIALS (DIRT, STONE, PAVEMENT, FORMING, ETC.) MUST BE KEPT WITHIN THE LIMITS OF CONSTRUCTION. WHEN THE CONSTRUCTION BARRIERS ARE MOVED DURING CONSTRUCTION, THE CLEANUP OF THE AREAS OUTSIDE THE BARRIERS SHALL OCCUR IMMEDIATELY.
- 12. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN POSITIVE DRAINAGE ON THE PROJECT FOR THE COMPLETE DURATION.
- 13. ALL EXISTING PAVEMENT THAT IS BEING OVERLAID SHALL HAVE NEW PAVEMENT MARKINGS PAINTED THAT MATCH THE EXISTING LAYOUT AND LOCATION. IT IS THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO LOCATE AND KEEP RECORD OF THE EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKINGS. THE MARKINGS SHALL INCLUDE THE PARKING SPACE NUMBER.
- 14. ALL ENTRANCES WHERE ASPHALT PAVING IS PERFORMED SHALL BE MILLED AND HEELED-IN TO ALLOW SMOOTH TRANSITIONING AS SHOWN ON THE DETAIL AND TYPICAL SECTION SHEET.
- 15. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL USE CITY OF WEST MILLFORD NOISE ORDINANCE HOURS AS WORKING HOURS FOR THE APPLICABLE HIGH SCHOOL LOCATION.

MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

MOBILIZATION

THE LUMP SUM BID ITEM FOR MOBILIZATION SHALL INCLUDE ANY MOBILIZATION AND DEMOBILIZATION OF EQUIPMENT AND MATERIAL THROUGHOUT THE DURATION OF THE PROJECT. THE CLEAN UP AND REMOVAL OF ANY DEBRIS PRODUCED FROM CONSTRUCTION AND ANY EXISTING DEBRIS WITHIN THE PROJECT AREA SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR AND SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO THE LUMP SUM BID ITEM FOR MOBILIZATION. THE BID FOR MOBILIZATION SHALL NOT EXCEED 10% OF THE TOTAL BASE BID.

EARTHWORK

ALL EXCAVATION NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH SUBGRADE FOR THE PROPOSED PAVEMENT SECTION, DRAINAGE PIPE, CONCRETE CURBS, ETC SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO THE VARIOUS BID ITEMS. ALL EXCESS EXCAVATED MATERIAL SHALL BECOME PROPERTY OF THE CONTRACTOR AND THEIR RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVING OFF SITE.

CONCRETE CURB

THE LINEAR FOOT PRICE FOR INDIVIDUAL CONCRETE CURBING SHALL INCLUDE ALL EXCAVATION, FORMING, MATERIAL, BACKFILLING BEHIND THE CURB, TIE INTO THE EXISTING CURB, AND ANY NECESSARY RESTORATION OF THE VEGETATION BEHIND THE CURB.

DRAINAGE STRUCTURES

THE EACH UNIT BID PRICE FOR DRAINAGE INLETS SHALL INCLUDE ALL EXCAVATION, CONCRETE, REBAR, GRATES, BACKFILL, PIPE GROUTING, etc. TO INSTALL THE STRUCTURE

THE LINEAR FOOT BID PRICE FOR DRAINAGE PIPE SHALL INCLUDE ALL EXCAVATION, MATERIAL, BACKFILL, RESTORATION OUTLET PROTECTION, etc NECESSARY TO INSTALL PIPE

ASPHALT PAVING

ASPHALT MILLING WILL BE NECESSARY ON THIS PROJECT AS INDICATED ON THE PLAN AND AT TYPICAL TRANSITIONING THE EXISTING PAVEMENT THAT IS TO REMAIN. CURB HEIGHTS AND POSITIVE DRAINAGE. THE COST OF MILLING SHALL BE IN PAID FOR BY THE SQUARE YARD UNIT BID PRICE AND SHOULD INCLUDE THE CONTRACTOR DISPOSAL OF THE MILLINGS.

THE COST OF TACK COAT SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO THE TONNAGE UNIT COST OF THE NEW ASPHALT.

THE COST OF ASPHALT PAVING SHALL BE PAID FOR BY THE TONNAGE UNIT BID PRICE AND SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ASPHALT THICKNESS SHOWN ON THE PLANS.

THE COST OF ASPHALT BASE COURSE SHALL INCLUDE ALL MATERIAL, COMPACTION etc TO ESTABLISH A SUBASE FOR FULL DEPTH REPAIR.

PAVEMENT MARKING/PAVEMENT BLOCKS








