- 3. ADD ½" 25GA Resilient Channel spaced at 24" O.C. to Wall Partition Type 2 on A5.02 and as shown on A1.01R attached to this addendum.
- 4. ADD 2 Fire Extinguish Cabinets in referenced locations on A1.01R attached to this addendum.
- 5. ADD A6.02 as attached to this addendum. Basis of Design by J.D. Signs or approved equal.
- 6. REPLACE note on 4/A3.01 to read 2.5% SLOPE on the ramp landing.

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SECTION 103000 - PORTABLE FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

PART 1 – GENERAL

- A. Submittals: Five copies of manufacturer's data and installation instructions.
- B. Manufacturers offering products to comply with the requirements for fire-fighting devices include the following:
 - 1. W.D. Allen Mfg. Co.
 - 2. Elkhart Brass Mfg. Co.
 - 3. General Fire Extinguisher Corp.
 - 4. Larsens
 - 5. Walter Kidde & Co.
 - 6. Norris Industries

PART 2 - MATERIALS

2.1 FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

- A. One UL labeled unit for each fire extinguisher cabinet.
 - 1. Multi-purpose dry chemical (ABC5-FrExt): 10 lbs. capacity, enameled steel container with pressure-indicating gauge, for Classes A, B, and C fires. Larsen's #MP10 or equal. Provide 2 units to be located in cabinet locations indicated on drawings or as directed in the field during construction.

2.2 FIRE EXTINGUISHER CABINETS

- A. Sized for housing one fire extinguisher unit as noted above with a 4" wall depth. (Provide 2 to be located where shown on the Floor Plan.)
 - 1. Recessed: Trim with beveled or rounded edges in contact with wall surface. Provide square corners with approximately 1 1/4" wide trim, unless otherwise indicated. Larsen's #2409 6R or equal.
 - 2. Construction: One-piece tubular door frames, mitered and welded. One piece metal trim frame, to suit cabinet styles required. Weld all joints and

grind smooth. Provide manufacturer's standard steel box with white baked enamel interior finish and primed exterior finish.

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2.3 STEEL DOORS AND TRIM

A. Manufacturer's standard, prime coat finished, flush steel door frame and trim.

2.4 DOOR PANELS

- A. Manufacturer's standard, as follows:
 - 1. Full glass panel, DSA glass, with catch.
 - 2. Door Hardware: 180 degrees operating continuous hinge with either lever handle with cam action latch or door pull and friction latch.

PART 3 - EXECUTION

3.1 INSTALLATION

- A. In accordance with manufacturer's directions for the type of mounting required.
 - 1. After installation, apply red letter decals spelling "Fire Extinguisher" size, style and location as required by NFPA or OSHA.
