TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

A Pre-Bid Conference was held on Wednesday, September 7, 2022, on the above-referenced project, a copy of the sign in sheet is included in this Addendum. The following are clarifications and responses to questions posed by contractors for the above reference project.

A. **GENERAL**

1. The B&O Tax form and the business license application forms for the City of Ravenswood have been included as an attachment to this addendum for reference. These forms do not need filled out or submitted with the bid and are for reference only. Only the successful bidder will be required to proceed with the process associated with these forms.

B. <u>SPECIFICATIONS</u>

D. <u>QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES</u>

1. QUESTION

Is there a funding sign?

RESPONSE No funding sign is required.

2. QUESTION

Signage on sheet 10 are these signs incidental to something?

RESPONSE

There will be a total of three accessible parking signs required for this project. They are to be placed on the back side of the sidewalk away from the parking spaces. Only

one of these signs is to designate a van accessible space. The other spaces will require only the reserved accessible parking sign.

3. QUESTION

Is the WVDOH entry permit in place?

RESPONSE

No. The engineer has submitted the MM-109 to the local district for review. Work on the project may proceed without this permit.

4. QUESTION

Is there any WVDOH fees or inspections we should include?

RESPONSE

No.

5. QUESTION

Is there a B&O tax if so what percentage?

RESPONSE

Refer to the attached B&O tax form for the City of Ravenswood. The percentage for contracting and building business is 2% of the taxable income.

6. QUESTION

Is there a specific labor scale we should use?

RESPONSE

Wage Rates do not apply

7. OUESTION

For any included street and road signs do you want break away posts?

RESPONSE Yes.

8. QUESTION

Is the electrical all-inclusive for a turnkey project? If not what portion of the electrical is to be built by others?

RESPONSE

Yes. The only portion of the electrical work to be excluded is the service extension to the meter, the meter socket, and the window type CT which are to be provided by AEP as noted. All other electrical work noted is to be performed by the contractor.

9. QUESTION

What diameter are the concrete pole bases?

RESPONSE

Light pole bases are to be 24 inches in diameter.

10. QUESTION

The handrail quantity is this for all five stair locations? Do you want handrail on both sides or one side?

RESPONSE

The quantity is for all five stair locations and includes handrail on both sides of the stair. Each railing is approximately 4'-0" in length from end to end and there are 10 railings total.

11. QUESTION

The Fencing Demo work, upon completion will fencing have to be reestablished and reinstalled?

RESPONSE

The fencing and gates that were identified to be removed are not to be reinstalled. All fencing and gates at the entrance not associated with the fence around the sewer lagoons are to be removed.

12. QUESTION

Where is the proposed septic fields where a perk test should be completed?

RESPONSE

There is no septic proposed on this project. Note #4 from sheet 05 is to be omitted from the bid.

13. QUESTION

Do the five tent sites get any surface material like stone or sand?

RESPONSE

Tent sites are to be grass areas and do <u>not</u> include any stone or sand. Any disturbance caused from utility and road construction in this area is to be stabilized with seeding and graded to have positive drainage toward the creek.

14. QUESTION

On sheet 09 you show a detail for concrete curbing type 1, where does it go and what is the quantity can you show a drawing for its location and add a bid item?

RESPONSE

Concrete curbing has been removed from the project. This detail is to be omitted from the bid.

15. QUESTION

Will BM & coordinate information be provided?

RESPONSE

Control will be established for the contractor prior to construction by the engineer. A CADD file with coordinate information will be provided to the contractor prior to construction. In addition northing and easting coordinate points are included in the plans on page 04.2.

16. QUESTION

Is Thrasher doing the compaction and concrete testing?

RESPONSE

Yes.

17. QUESTION

In talking with paving contractors it appears everyone is booked through the 2022 season and no one is willing to promise this project will be paved due to their own current work on hand. If this is the case will substantial completion be granted and paving allowed to proceed in the spring of 2023 when the plants open again?

RESPONSE

The hope is to have the project completed in the timeframe outlined in the bid documents. In the event that asphalt paving is the lone item that cannot be completed substantial completion will be granted and asphalt paving will be allowed to commence when the plants open in 2023. All other work is to be completed in the timeframe for completion dates outlined in the contract documents. Consideration will not be given to change orders for the difference in installation times of the

asphalt paving and the unit price submitted in your bids is to apply regardless of when this work takes place.

18. QUESTION

Is there a need for a night watchman in this area?

RESPONSE

The contractor is responsible for the security of their equipment and materials for the project. A night watchman is not a requirement of bidding the project and methods of project material security will be left to the discretion of the contractor.

19. QUESTION

Is the contractor to supply Panel A & B and the MDP and mounting assembly shown on sheet 16?

RESPONSE

Yes. Contractor is also responsible for the supply of the CT cabinet. Items identified in the plans as being installed or supplied by the customer are the responsibility of the contractor for this contract and should be included in the bid. AEP is responsible for the extension of service to the connection point, providing the meter socket, and the Window Type CT.

20. QUESTION

Is there any wire in the Lighting conduit?

RESPONSE

Yes, wiring for all electrical components of the project is to be included in Bid Item #21 New Electric Service.

21. QUESTION

Are we only to install a pull string in the pedestal conduits?

RESPONSE

Pull string is to be installed in all conduits.

E. <u>CLARIFICATIONS</u>

1. At the pre-bid meeting the question was posed if there was a dump site available for use by the contractor during construction. A dump site is available nearby to the project site located to the east of the sewer lagoons and on road travel is not required to access this site. The city will allow topsoil to be disposed of here and that must be coordinated with the city during construction and prior to any placement of topsoil in this location. No construction debris or other non-natural material is to be deposited in this location and such waste is to be hauled off site and disposed of at a proper location with proper permits in place.
