#### ADDENDUM #1 March 22, 2023

#### TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

A Pre-Bid Conference was held on Thursday, March 16, 2023, on the above-referenced project, a copy of the sign in sheet is included in this Addendum. The following are clarifications and responses to questions posed by contractors for the above reference project.

#### A. <u>GENERAL</u>

- 1. Insurance Certificates must be provided as part of the bid opening requirements. All bid opening requirements and the bid can be submitted in one envelope. The two-envelope system as indicated in the Bid Opening Checklist has been Changed. The Bid Opening Checklist has been revised as part of this addendum.
- 2. THE BID FORM HAS BEEN REVISED. YOU MUST USE THE REVISED BID FORM WHEN PREPARING YOUR BID PACKAGE FOR THIS PROJECT.

#### **B. SPECIFICATIONS**

1. Bid Opening Requirement page has been updated.

#### D. **QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES**

#### **OUESTION**

1. Is the assumption for the "Existing Gravel area" to be left in place, and graded for asphalt?

#### **RESPONSE**

Yes.

#### **QUESTION**

2. A "proposed yard hydrant" is shown located next to the "proposed relocated bill pay box". Please clarify corridor for the waterline to feed the hydrant.

#### **RESPONSE**

The water line connection will be provided by the Town from the existing building, for this yard hydrant.

#### **QUESTION**

3. What mill and overlay depth of the "mill and overlay" area?

#### RESPONSE

1 ½" mill and overlay.

#### **QUESTION**

4. Will the awarded contractor be required to obtain a Gordonsville Business License?

#### RESPONSE

If the contractor's office resides within the Town limits, then a business license is required. Otherwise, no.

#### **QUESTION**

5. Will a representative for Gordonsville be onsite full time to verify quantities?

#### **RESPONSE**

It has not been determined yet whether there will be full-time representation on this project on behalf of the owner or not. In the event the contractor feels there is an issue with a quantity, the contractor should notify the Town and the Engineer. In the event there is quantity overrun, and it is an agreed upon overrun. These will be paid for at the unit rate provided in the bid form.

#### **QUESTION**

6. Will the town repair the Hardscape at the water location of the water tap?

#### RESPONSE

The Town will provide the tap and extend the line so that the contractor does not have to repair the hardscape.

#### E. <u>CLARIFICATIONS</u>

1. The contractor will be responsible for material testing. Material testing will be required within the full depth pavement repair sections, the aggregate base course, asphalt paving, and concrete. A line item for material testing has been added to the Bid Form.

- 2. The pole relocation bid item # 14 is for the contractor's coordination efforts during this process. It is anticipated that the pole will be removed by the utility.
- 3. The stamped concrete patio has been removed.

#### ARTICLE 3—BASIS OF BID—LUMP SUM BID AND UNIT PRICES

#### **GENERAL**

The Bidder shall take notice of and shall be responsible for any local or state taxes levied and applicable, and the cost for the same shall be included as part of the submitted Bid.

The total Bid cost stated includes a complete operating installation including furnishing and installation of any and all changes or additions in plans, piping, mechanical work, additional electrical work, accessories, controls, etc. necessary to accommodate alternative equipment systems or materials used in construction.

Bidder has carefully studied the reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and the drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, with respect to the Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
- 5. Bidder has carefully studied the reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.

Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and the Technical Data identified in the Supplementary Conditions or by definition, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and Technical Data on (a) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (b) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder, if selected as Contractor; and (c) Bidder's (Contractor's) safety precautions and programs.
- 7. Based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, Bidder agrees that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the performance of the Work at the Contract Price, within the Contract Times, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Contract.
- 8. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- 9. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and of discrepancies between Site conditions and the Contract Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Contractor.






