

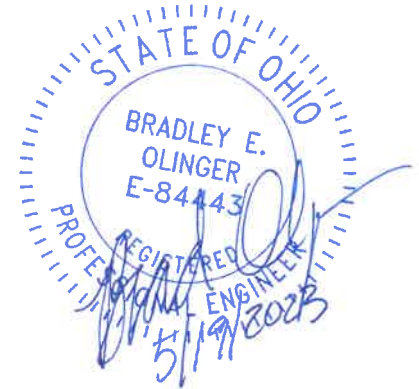

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The following are clarifications and responses to questions posed by contractors for the above-referenced project.

A. GENERAL

1. **THE BID OPENING DATE HAS CHANGED FROM MONDAY, MAY 22, 2023, AT 10:00 AM TO THURSDAY, MAY 25, 2023, AT 10:00 AM.**

B. QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES

QUESTION 1

There is a plan note on page 19 of 41 "Item 507, 14" Cast-in-place reinforced concrete piles, as per plan" that calls for a minimum wall thickness of 5/8", per our suppliers and the KIPS per pile the thickness could be .25", please verify is the thickness is required.

RESPONSE

S&ME performed a pile drivability analysis using GRLWEAP for a 1/4" and 3/8" pile wall thickness. The analysis showed that in both cases, the stresses were within the acceptable range. Thrasher then did a check on the lateral stability and based on those calculations a 1/4" and 3/8" were not acceptable. Therefore a 5/8" wall thickness will be required. Per ODOT CMS 507.06, the cylindrical casing shall conform to 711.03.

Sealed bids for TUS-E. 20TH ST. will be received by the City of Dover, Tuscarawas County, Ohio in the office of the Director of Public Service, Municipal Building, 116 East Third Street Rear, Dover, Ohio 44622 until 10:00 AM, **Thursday, May 25th, 2023**, and then publicly opened and read aloud.

All proposals shall be sealed and endorsed "TUS – E. 20TH ST."

To bid on this project and be considered a plan holder you MUST download the digital project bidding documents from QuestCDN and pay the download delivery fee. Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid guaranty in the form of 1) a certified check, or cashier's check, or letter of credit, equal to 10% of the bid; or 2) a bid guaranty bond for the full amount of the bid; both forms of guaranty as provided in Chapter 153 of the Ohio Revised Code and in the project specifications. The amount of the bid for said guaranty purposes shall include all additive and deductive alternates. All bid guaranties shall be conditioned that if the bid is accepted within sixty (60) days of the bid opening, a proper contract shall be executed, and that upon failure or refusal to enter into said contract within ten (10) days after receipt of notification of award, the bidder and the surety on any bond shall be liable to the city in an amount not to exceed 10% of the bid.

Each bidder must ensure that all employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, creed, color, sex or national origin.

All bids shall comply with all of the requirements of the drawings, specifications and contract documents.

Attention of bidders is called to all of the requirements contained in these specifications and contract documents, particularly to the Federal Labor Standards Provisions and Davis-Bacon Wages, various insurance requirements, various equal opportunity provisions, and the requirement for a payment bond and performance bond.

The right is reserved to reject any or all bids.

All bidders must be pre-qualified with ODOT. Bidders must possess work types and perform work equal to at least 30% of the total amount of the submitted bid price.

Domestic steel use requirements, Federal wage rates and disadvantaged business requirements apply to this project.
