TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

A Pre-Bid Conference was held on Wednesday, August 9, 2023, on the above-referenced project, a copy of the sign in sheet is included in this Addendum. The following are clarifications and responses to questions posed by contractors for the above reference project.

A. GENERAL

1. THE BID FORM HAS BEEN REVISED. YOU MUST USE THE REVISED BID FORM WHEN PREPARING YOUR BID PACKAGE FOR THIS PROJECT.

B. QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES

1. QUESTION

What is the Engineer's Estimate for this project?

RESPONSE

The Engineer's Estimate is \$750,000.

2. QUESTION

Who is responsible for paying the DOH Fees?

RESPONSE

The project funding covers the DOH fees for this project. The Owner will cover payment of the DOH fees by project funding.

3. QUESTION

Are all the permits completed?

RESPONSE

All permits are in hand.

4. QUESTION

What will be the notice to proceed for construction on this project?

RESPONSE

There is a 90-day bid hold, but the plan is to be able to proceed within 60 days.

5. QUESTION

When is the kickoff for construction projected to be?

RESPONSE

The plan is for the construction to kick off by the end of October or the beginning of November.

6. QUESTION

Will the contract be extended if there is an extensive material lead time?

RESPONSE

The contract time is set for 150 days to account for material lead time. However, if proper documentation from the awarded contractor is provided for the delay in construction materials, then an extension will be taken under consideration.

7. QUESTION

Will the contractor be responsible if the gravel roads get torn up from snow plowing?

RESPONSE

The awarded contractor shall be responsible for road repairs that are shown in the Contract Plans as well as any road repairs and restoration that are necessary due to damage caused by waterline installation. Additional road repairs and restoration will be required to restore roads and existing lands to preexisting conditions as documented by the Pre-Construction Video. Adequate documentation of these repairs is required. If the roads are damaged by anything or anyone not associated with the project, the contractor will not be responsible for those repairs.

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8. QUESTION

Will directional drilling be allowed for this project?

RESPONSE

Directional drilling is not acceptable for waterline installation for this project.

C. CLARIFICATIONS

- The IJDC # on the Plans and Contract Documents and Detailed Specifications is wrong and it will be updated on the Construction drawings that will be provided to the awarded contractor. The correct WVIJDC # for the Critical Needs Waterline Extension for the Marshall County Public Service District #3 is WVIJDC #2023W-2362.
- 2. The Awarded Contractor will not be required to set up an Office Trailer for this project.
- 3. Any restoration or road repair to be performed on this project because of damage caused by waterline installation that is not called out in the Contract Plans shall be included in the waterline bid unit price(s). Additional restoration and road repair shall be required to restore roads and lands to their existing conditions as documented by the Pre-Construction Video.

Bidder has carefully studied the reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and the drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, with respect to the Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
- 5. Bidder has carefully studied the reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
- 6. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and the Technical Data identified in the Supplementary Conditions or by definition, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and Technical Data on (a) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (b) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder, if selected as Contractor; and (c) Bidder's (Contractor's) safety precautions and programs.
- 7. Based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, Bidder agrees that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the performance of the Work at the Contract Price, within the Contract Times, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Contract.
- 8. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- 9. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and of discrepancies between Site conditions and the Contract Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Contractor.
- 10. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for performance and furnishing of the Work.
- 11. The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.

8.02 Bidder's Certifications

A. The Bidder certifies the following:

- 1. This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any collusive agreement or rules of any group, association, organization, or corporation.
- 2. Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid.
- 3. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding.
- 4. Bidder has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 8.02.A:
 - a. Corrupt practice means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process.
 - b. Fraudulent practice means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition.

- c. Collusive practice means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels.
