The Capital Area Development Corporation of West Virginia EDA #01-79-15296 will be partially funded with federal funds from the United States Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration and therefore is subject to the Federal Laws and regulations associated with that program.

The Project includes the following Work:

Demolish several buildings on this site as indicated on the construction drawings. Project includes selective Demolition of the building located at 1520 Dixie Street, Charleston, WV. Partial demolition will include removal of all amenities with the exception of the steel primary and secondary structure, foundations, and portions of the existing slab. All utilities are to be removed from this and all other buildings to be fully demolished under this contract.

The Work will be substantially completed within 120 calendar days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run and completed and ready for final payment within 150 days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run. Liquidated damages shall be \$1,000 per day.

A bidder may not withdraw his bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date set for the opening of bids.

Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to Capital Area Development Corporation of West Virginia in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the base bid.

Contractor is required to provide the Drug Free Workplace Certification in accordance with WV Code 21-1D-5.

<u>Suspension and Debarment</u> – Recipient shall not entertain the use of businesses that are listed on the "System for Award Management" (SAM) at <u>www.Sam.gov</u> in accordance with 2 CFR Part 1532 and Subpart B and C of 2 CFR Part 180.

## NOTICE OF FEDERAL WAGE REQUIREMENTS
