1. QUESTION

Can we use stoplights for traffic control or do we have to use flaggers?

Does the material from clearing and grubbing on railroad property need to be removed from the site?

What size line is the proposed waterline?

Can directional drilling be used?

RESPONSE

Directional drilling will be considered as a possible alternative. HDPE with equivalent pressure rating will be considered an acceptable alternative to PVC.

5. QUESTION

Will the crossing under the railroad require steel casing?

RESPONSE

Yes, the railroad will require steel casing as shown on the plans.

6. QUESTION

Is 115 LF of steel casing required for the railroad right of way crossing?

RESPONSE

Yes.



- Removal and replacement of the existing vertical paddle flocculators, sedimentation basin chain and flight collection equipment.

- Removal and replacement of the existing high service pumps, piping and various valves.
- Upgrades to the existing electrical power service.
