1.02 The undersigned Bidder proposes and agrees, if this Bid is accepted, to enter into an Agreement with Owner in the form included in the Bidding Documents to perform all Work as specified or indicated in the Bidding Documents for the prices and within the times indicated in this Bid and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.

ARTICLE 3—BASIS OF BID—LUMP SUM BID AND UNIT PRICES

GENERAL

The Bidder shall take notice of and shall be responsible for any local or state taxes levied and applicable, and the cost for the same shall be included as part of the submitted Bid.

The total Bid cost stated includes a complete operating installation including furnishing and installation of any and all changes or additions in plans, piping, mechanical work, additional electrical work, accessories, controls, etc. necessary to accommodate alternative equipment systems or materials used in construction.

BID PROPOSAL

7.01 *Bid Acceptance Period*

- A. This Bid will remain subject to acceptance for 90 days after the Bid opening, or for such longer period of time that Bidder may agree to in writing upon request of Owner.

7.02 *Instructions to Bidders*

- A. Bidder accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Instructions to Bidders, including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of Bid security.

ARTICLE 8—BIDDER'S REPRESENTATIONS AND CERTIFICATIONS

8.01 *Bidder's Representations*

- A. In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents the following:
 - 1. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, including Addenda.

2. Bidder has visited the Site, conducted a thorough visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
3. Bidder is familiar with all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
4. Bidder has carefully studied the reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and the drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, with respect to the Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
5. Bidder has carefully studied the reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
6. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and the Technical Data identified in the Supplementary Conditions or by definition, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and Technical Data on (a) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (b) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder, if selected as Contractor; and (c) Bidder's (Contractor's) safety precautions and programs.
7. Based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, Bidder agrees that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the performance of the Work at the Contract Price, within the Contract Times, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Contract.
8. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
9. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and of discrepancies between Site conditions and the Contract Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Contractor.
10. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for performance and furnishing of the Work.
11. The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.

8.02 *Bidder's Certifications*

A. The Bidder certifies the following:

1. This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any collusive agreement or rules of any group, association, organization, or corporation.
2. Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid.
3. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding.

4. Bidder has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 8.02.A:
 - a. Corrupt practice means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process.
 - b. Fraudulent practice means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition.
 - c. Collusive practice means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels.
 - d. Coercive practice means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the execution of the Contract.

GENERAL NOTES:

1. THE GOVERNING SPECIFICATIONS FOR THIS PROJECT WILL BE THE WEST VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS, ROADS AND BRIDGES, ADOPTED 2023 AND LATEST SUPPLEMENTAL SPECIFICATIONS.
2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL LOCATE AND PROTECT EXISTING UTILITIES AND FACILITIES FROM DAMAGE BY EQUIPMENT OR PERSONNEL. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT ALL UTILITY AND FACILITY AGENCIES FOR FIELD MARKING PRIOR TO BEGINNING CONSTRUCTION INCLUDING MISS UTILITY. THE LOCATIONS OF EXISTING UNDERGROUND UTILITIES ARE SHOWN IN AN APPROXIMATE WAY ONLY AND HAVE NOT BEEN INDEPENDENTLY VERIFIED BY THE OWNER OR ITS REPRESENTATIVE. THE EXISTING UTILITY INFORMATION IS THE BEST AVAILABLE AND MAY NOT BE COMPLETELY ACCURATE OR REPRESENTATIVE OF ACTUAL CONDITIONS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL DETERMINE THE EXACT LOCATION OF ALL EXISTING UTILITIES BEFORE COMMENCING WORK, AND AGREES TO BE FULLY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY AND ALL DAMAGES WHICH MIGHT BE OCCASIONED BY THE UNDERGROUND UTILITIES. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER AND/OR OWNER IN WRITING, OF ANY EXISTING DAMAGED UTILITIES PRIOR TO BEGINNING CONSTRUCTION. ANY UTILITIES OR FACILITIES DAMAGED DURING THE PROJECT BY THE CONTRACTOR OR EQUIPMENT SHALL BE PROMPTLY REPAIRED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE. HAND DIGGING TO PROTECT UTILITIES FROM DAMAGE SHOULD BE ANTICIPATED.
3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL HAVE ON THE SITE AT ALL TIMES A COMPETENT SUPERINTENDENT CAPABLE OF READING AND UNDERSTANDING THE CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS AND THOROUGHLY EXPERIENCED IN THE TYPE OF WORK BEING PERFORMED, AND SHALL BE ABLE TO COORDINATE WITH THE ENGINEER.
4. THE CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS REPRESENT THE PROPOSED LINES, GRADES, AND APPURTENANCE TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTEND OF THE SCOPE OF WORK. CERTAIN INCIDENTAL ITEMS TO COMPLETE THE SCOPE OF WORK MAY NOT BE SHOWN.
5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING A VALID WEST VIRGINIA GENERAL CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE AND PAYING ALL APPLICABLE STATE AND LOCAL TAXES.
6. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR VERIFICATION OF ALL PLAN AND ELEVATION DIMENSIONS OF THE VARIOUS WORK ITEMS ON THIS PROJECT.
7. IN THE EVENT AN ERROR WITH THE PLANS SEEMS APPARENT, THE MATTER MUST BE TAKEN UP WITH THE ENGINEER FOR CAREFUL REVIEW BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH CONSTRUCTION.
8. THE OWNER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CONTRACT TO AND PERFORM OTHER OR ADDITIONAL WORK ADJACENT TO AND WITHIN THE WORK AREA COVERED BY THIS CONTRACT. WHEN SEPARATE CONTRACTS ARE LET WITHIN THE LIMITS OF ANY ONE PROJECT, EACH CONTRACTOR SHALL CONDUCT THEIR WORK SO AS NOT TO INTERFERE WITH OR HINDER THE PROGRESS OR THE COMPLETION OF THE WORK BEING COMPLETED BY OTHER CONTRACTORS. THE CONTRACTORS WORKING ON THE SAME PROJECT SHALL COOPERATE WITH EACH OTHER AS ORDERED BY THE OWNER AND/OR ENGINEER.
9. ALL DISTURBED AREAS, INCLUDING THE CONTRACTORS STAGING AREA, GRADING LIMITS, WASTE AREAS, ETC. SHALL BE RESTORED TO A SMOOTH LINE AND GRADE WITH POSITIVE DRAINAGE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SEED AND MULCH ALL DISTURBED AREAS. THERE WILL BE NO MEASUREMENT FOR PAYMENT OF SEEDING.
10. ALL BROKEN CONCRETE & ASPHALT, TRASH, RUBBISH, ORGANICS, & OTHER UNSUITABLE MATERIAL SHALL BE DISPOSED OF OFF SITE BY THE CONTRACTOR.
11. ALL LOOSE MATERIALS (DIRT, STONE, PAVEMENT, FORMING, ETC.) MUST BE KEPT WITHIN THE LIMITS OF CONSTRUCTION. WHEN THE CONSTRUCTION BARRIERS ARE MOVED DURING CONSTRUCTION, THE CLEANUP OF THE AREAS OUTSIDE THE BARRIERS SHALL OCCUR IMMEDIATELY.
12. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN POSITIVE DRAINAGE ON THE PROJECT FOR THE COMPLETE DURATION.
13. ALL EXISTING PAVEMENT THAT IS BEING OVERLAID SHALL HAVE NEW PAVEMENT MARKINGS PAINTED THAT MATCH THE EXISTING LAYOUT AND LOCATION. IT IS THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO LOCATE AND KEEP RECORD OF THE EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKINGS.
14. ALL ENTRANCES WHERE ASPHALT PAVING IS PERFORMED SHALL BE MILLED AND HEeled-IN TO ALLOW SMOOTH TRANSITIONING AS SHOWN ON THE DETAIL AND TYPICAL SECTION SHEET.
15. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL USE THE CITY OF SPENCER NOISE ORDINANCE HOURS AS WORKING HOURS FOR THE APPLICABLE SCHOOL LOCATION.
16. THE EXISTING SPEED BUMPS SHALL BE REMOVED AND RESET AFER PAVING IS COMPLETE IN THE THE SAME LOCATION.

MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

MOBILIZATION

THE LUMP SUM BID ITEM FOR MOBILIZATION SHALL INCLUDE ANY MOBILIZATION AND DEMOBILIZATION OF EQUIPMENT AND MATERIAL THROUGHOUT THE DURATION OF THE PROJECT. THE CLEAN UP AND REMOVAL OF ANY DEBRIS PRODUCED FROM CONSTRUCTION AND ANY EXISTING DEBRIS WITHIN THE PROJECT AREA SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR AND SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO THE LUMP SUM BID ITEM FOR MOBILIZATION. THE BID FOR MOBILIZATION SHALL NOT EXCEED 10% OF THE TOTAL BASE BID.

EARTHWORK

ALL EXCAVATION NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH SUBGRADE FOR THE PROPOSED PAVEMENT SECTION, FULL DEPTH PAVEMENT REPAIR, , ETC SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO THE VARIOUS BID ITEMS. ALL EXCESS EXCAVATED MATERIAL SHALL BECOME PROPERTY OF THE CONTRACTOR AND THEIR RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVING OFF SITE.

ASPHALT PAVING

ASPHALT MILLING WILL BE NECESSARY ON THIS PROJECT AS INDICATED ON THE PLAN AND AT TYPICAL TRANSITIONING THE EXISTING PAVEMENT THAT IS TO REMAIN. CURB HEIGHTS AND POSITIVE DRAINAGE. THE COST OF MILLING SHALL BE IN PAID FOR BY THE SQUARE FOOT UNIT BID PRICE AND SHOULD INCLUDE THE CONTRACTOR DISPOSAL OF THE MILLINGS.

THE COST OF TACK COAT SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO THE TONNAGE UNIT COST OF THE NEW ASPHALT.

THE COST OF ASPHALT PAVING SHALL BE PAID FOR BY THE TONNAGE UNIT BID PRICE AND SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ASPHALT THICKNESS SHOWN ON THE PLANS.

THE COST OF AGGREGATE BASE COURSE SHALL BE PAID FOR BY THE CUBIC YARD UNIT BID PRICE AND SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ASPHALT THICKNESS SHOWN ON THE PLANS.

THE COST OF SEPARATION FABRIC SHALL BE PAID FOR BY THE SY UNIT BID PRICE.

PAVEMENT MARKING / PARKING BLOCKS

THE COST OF THE PAVEMENT MARKING SHALL INCLUDE ALL NECESSARY MARKINGS; PARKING STRIPS, SPACE NUMBERS, ETC.

PARKING BLOCK COST, SHALL INCLUDE THE FURNISHING AND INSTALLING OF NEW RUBBER BLOCK.

CONCRETE CURB



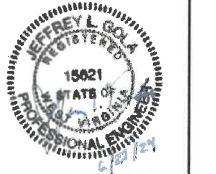
