CONTRACTOR'S CERTIFICATION OF DBE PARTICIPATION

The bidder shall make good faith efforts, as defined in Appendix "A" of 49 CFR Part 23, Regulations of the Office of the Secretary of Transportation, to subcontract percent of the dollar value of the prime contract to small business concerns owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals (DBE). In the event that the bidder for this solicitation qualifies as a DBE, the contract goal shall be deemed to have been met. Individuals who are rebuttably presumed to be socially and economically disadvantaged include women, Blacks, Hispanics, Native Americans, Asian-Pacific Americans, and Asian-Indian Americans. The apparent successful competitor will be required to submit information concerning the DBE's that will participate in this contract. The information will include the name and address of each DBE, a description of the work to be performed by each named firm, and the dollar value of the contract. If the bidder fails to achieve the contract goal stated herein, it will be required to provide documentation demonstrating that it made a good faith efforts in attempting to do so. A bid that fails to meet these requirements will be considered nonresponsive.

All bidders must submit an assurance stating the percentage of Disadvantage Businesses they intend to employ on this project.

Within a reasonable time after the opening of bids and before the award of a contract, all bidders or proposers wishing to remain in competition for the contract shall submit:

1. Names(s) of Disadvantage Business Enterprise/Joint Venture subcontractor(s).
2. Description of work each is to perform.
3. Dollar value of each proposed Disadvantaged Business/Joint Venture subcontract.
4. If DBE goals cannot be met, documentation showing good faith efforts.

REQUIRED ASSURANCE TO BE INCLUDED IN ALL BID PROPOSALS

This firm assures that it will utilize not less than 5.21% of Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Firms.
