General Notice

Mason County Public Service District (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Henderson Water Line Extension
T10-11185

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the **Mason Public County Public Service District** located at **101 Camden Avenue, Point Pleasant, WV 25550**, until **Thursday, February 6, 2025**, at **2:00 pm** local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

Contract #1

A tie-in to Mason County Public Service District's existing 10" water line along State Route 817, installation of approximately 36,100 LF of 10" PVC water line, 380 LF of 10" ductile iron water line, 650 LF of 12" HDPE horizontal directional drill, 130 LF of 20" steel casing pipe (bore and jack), 300 LF of 20" steel casing pipe (open cut), 18 fire hydrants, restoration of disturbed areas, and all other necessary appurtenances for a complete and operational potable water system.

Contract #2

Construction of a new 208,000-Gallon Water Storage Tank at the existing Beech Hill Tank Site including a tie-in to the existing 10" waterline, new telemetry, upgrades to the site including additional fencing, improvements to the gravel access road, and additional drainage, and all other necessary appurtenances for a complete and operational potable water storage system.

The Work will be substantially completed and ready for final payment after the date when the Contract Times commence to run as listed above. Liquidated damages shall be \$1,500 per day.

A two-envelope system will be used.

Envelope No. 1 must have the following information presented on the front:

Name and address of Bidder

Bid on Contract – Contract #1 - Henderson Water Line Extension
Contract #2 – Beech Hill Tank #2
Received by the Mason County Public Service District

Envelope No. 2 labeled “Bid Proposal” shall also be placed inside of Envelope #1.

Envelope No. 1 will be opened first and the Bid Opening Requirement items checked for compliance as outlined on the Bid Opening Checklist on page BOR - 1 of these contract documents. If such documents are found to be in order, Envelope No. 2 “Bid Proposal”, will then be opened and will be publicly read aloud. If the documents required to be contained in Envelope No. 1 are not in order, Envelope No. 2 “Bid Proposal” will not be opened and the Bid will be considered non-responsive and will be returned to the Bidder.

A bidder may not withdraw his bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date set for the opening of bids.

Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to Mason County Public Service District in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the base bid.

Suspension and Debarment – Recipient shall not entertain the use of businesses that are listed on the “System for Award Management” (SAM) at www.Sam.gov in accordance with 2 CFR Part 1532 and Subpart B and C of 2 CFR Part 180.

Drug Free Workplace - West Virginia Code 21-1D-5 provides that any solicitation for a public improvement construction contract requires each vendor that submits a bid for the work to submit at the same time an affidavit of compliance with the bid. The enclosed drug-free workplace affidavit must be signed and submitted in the first envelope as evidence of the vendor’s compliance with the provisions of Article 1D, Chapter 21 of the West Virginia code. Failure to submit the signed drug-free workplace affidavit in the first envelope shall result in disqualification of such bid.

Notice of Federal Wage Requirements – Contractors are required to comply with all laws pertaining to federal wage rates as issued in accordance with the Davis Bacon act. The contractor will be required to pay the federal wage rates appropriate for each worker classification.

All Bidders are required to have a West Virginia Contractor’s License per Section §30-42-12 of the West Virginia Code.

Bids received after the scheduled closing time for the reception of bids will be returned unopened to the bidders.

The Mason County Public Service District reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Pre-bid Conference

A pre-bid conference for the Project will be held on **Tuesday, January 21, 2025, at 10:00 am** at **Mason County Public Service District, 101 Camden Avenue, Point Pleasant WV, 25550**. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is encouraged but not required.
