The Project includes the following Work:

The project is a conference room addition to an existing support services building. The exterior scope of the project includes new parking lot asphalt paving. Site work will also include a new building entrance pedestrian ramp. The exterior scope of the new addition includes demolition of an existing deck and reusing existing foundations. The new addition will be built with wood framing and roof trusses. The exterior finishes will be vinyl siding and asphalt shingle roofing. New vinyl windows will also be installed. The interior scope of the project includes a conference room, bathroom, and storage room. The spaces will be finished with painted gypsum board walls and resilient vinyl plank flooring. Ceilings will be painted gypsum board. New lighting, mechanical (heat pump system), electrical power (within existing panel and service), plumbing (tied into existing supply and waste lines), and fire protection equipment shall be installed.

Bids are requested for the following Contract: Camden Family Health Conference Room Addition

The Work will be substantially completed within 180 calendar days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run and completed and ready for final payment within 30 days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run. Liquidated damages shall be \$500.00 per day.

Envelope No. 1 will be opened first and the Bid Opening Requirement items checked for compliance as outlined on the Bid Opening Checklist of these contract documents. If such documents are found to be in order, Envelope No. 2 "Bid Proposal", will then be opened. If the documents required to be contained in Envelope No. 1 are not in order, Envelope No. 2 "Bid Proposal" will not be opened, and the Bid will be considered non-responsive and will be returned to the Bidder.

A bidder may not withdraw his bid for a period of ninety (30) days after the date set for the opening of bids.

Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to Camden Family Health, Inc. in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the base bid.

All Bidders are required to have a West Virginia Contractor's License per Section §30-42-12 of the West Virginia Code. Bids received after the scheduled closing time for the reception of bids will be returned unopened to the bidders.

Webster County Commission reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

For all further requirements regarding bid submittal, qualifications, procedures, and contract award, refer to the Instructions to Bidders that are included in the Bidding Documents.

Bidders will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order 11246, HUD Section 109, which prohibits discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex, or national origin, and have non-segregated facilities.

This Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project is to be financed in part by a grant from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the West Virginia Department of Economic Development (WVDED) and will be referred to as the Webster County Commission Camden Family Health Buildout project.

The work to be performed under this contract is subject to the requirements of Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968, as amended, 12 U.S.C. 170l u (Section 3). The purpose of Section 3 is to ensure that employment and other economic opportunities generated by HUD assistance or HUD-assisted projects covered by Section 3, shall, to the greatest extent feasible, be directed to low- and very low-income persons, particularly persons who are recipients of HUD assistance for housing.

The parties to this contract agree to comply with HUD's regulations in 24 CFR Part 135, which implements Section 3. Bidders' attention is directed to the Section 3 "Clause" set forth in the contract documents.

Bidders must comply with the requirements for Affirmative Action and Minority Business Enterprises participation as described in the Federal Specifications inserted into the Contract Documents. Bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Copeland Act, the Contract Work Hours, the Safety Act, the Build America, Buy America Act, and the West Virginia Division of Labor Wages for Construction of Public Improvements pursuant to West Virginia Code §21-5A-3.

No Bid shall be waived or returned because the Bidder failed to or cannot comply with any requirements as set forth in the Plans and Specifications, or any applicable statutes of the United States, the State of West Virginia and/or local ordinances.

No Bidder may withdraw their bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the time of the opening of the Bids.
