General Notice

Warm Springs Public Service District & Town of Bath (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Contract #1 - US Route 522 South Sewer and Water Line Extensions 020-10154

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received by the Warm Springs Public Service District and the Town of Bath at the **Morgan County Courthouse** located at **77 Fairfax Street, Berkeley Springs, WV 25411**, until **Wednesday, June 24, 2026 at 10:00 am** local time. At that time the Bids received will be **publicly** opened and read.

The **Warm Springs Public Service District & Town of Bath** EDA #01-79-15347 will be partially funded with federal funds from the United States Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration and therefore is subject to the Federal Laws and regulations associated with that program.

The Project includes the following Work:

The installation of approximately 10,750 linear feet (LF) of 8" Gravity Sewer Pipe, 50 each (EA) manholes, 4000 LF of 6" Force Main, two (2) pump stations, and all necessary related appurtenances. Additionally, this contract will include the installation of approximately 12,000 LF of 8" waterline, 12 EA 8" gate valves, 12 EA fire hydrant assemblies, and all necessary related appurtenances.

Bids are requested for the following Contract: **Contract #1 - US Route 522 South Sewer and Water Line Extensions**

The Work will be substantially completed within 330 calendar days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run, and completed and ready for final payment within 360 days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run. Liquidated damages shall be \$1,000 per day.

A two envelope system will be used.

Envelope No. 1 must have the following information presented on the front:

Name and address of Bidder
Bid on Contract – Contract #1 - US Route 522 South Sewer and Water Line Extensions
Received by the Warm Springs Public Service District & Town of Bath Public Service District

Envelope No. 2 labeled "Bid Proposal" shall also be placed inside of Envelope #1.

Envelope No. 1 will be opened first and the Bid Opening Requirement items checked for compliance as outlined on the Bid Opening Checklist on page BOR - 1 of these contract documents. If such documents are found to be in order, Envelope No. 2 “Bid Proposal”, will then be opened and will be publicly read aloud. If the documents required to be contained in Envelope No. 1 are not in order, Envelope No. 2 “Bid Proposal” will not be opened and the Bid will be considered non-responsive and will be returned to the Bidder.

A bidder may not withdraw his bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date set for the opening of bids.

Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to Warm Springs Public Service District & Town of Bath in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the base bid.

Contractor is required to provide the Drug Free Workplace Certification in accordance with WV Code 21-1D-5.

DBE Requirements - Each Bidder must fully Comply with the Disadvantaged Business Enterprises, and Affirmative Action Requirements, as identified in the contract documents.

The Bidder agrees to make “positive efforts” to subcontract a portion of the total value of the contract to Disadvantaged Business Enterprises. This shall be done in compliance with the six (6) affirmative steps as outlined in 40 CFR 33.240. Failure to demonstrate positive efforts to do so may lead to rejection of bids. For this program, the term “subcontract” includes all construction, modification, and service work contracted for by the bidder in the execution of the work under this contract.

Suspension and Debarment – Recipient shall not entertain the use of businesses that are listed on the “System for Award Management” (SAM) at www.Sam.gov in accordance with 2 CFR Part 1532 and Subpart B and C of 2 CFR Part 180. The bidder who is awarded the contract must maintain an active SAM registration throughout the project.

Prospective Bidders should note that this Contract will include the following critical requirements as identified in the Contract Documents.

1. Affirmative Action Program Requirements and Goals
2. Certificate of Non-Segregated Facilities
3. Specific Labor Standard Provisions
4. WV Contract Licensing Act – All bidders are required to have a WV Contractor’s License per Section 30-42-12 of the WV Code.

Notice of Federal Wage Requirements – Contractors are required to comply with all laws pertaining to federal wage rates as issued in accordance with the Davis Bacon act. The contractor will be required to pay the federal wage rates appropriate for each worker classification.

Build America, Buy America Requirements – P.L. 117-58, Infrastructure Investment and Jobs (IIJA) Act, 2021 (Act), includes a “Build America, Buy America (BABA)” requirement in Sections 70911 through 70917 that requires federally funded assistance recipients to use iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials that are produced in the United States for projects for the construction, alteration, maintenance, or repair of a public water system or treatment works.

All Bidders are required to have a West Virginia Contractor’s License per Section §30-42-12 of the West Virginia Code.

Bids received after the scheduled closing time for the reception of bids will be returned unopened to the bidders.

The Warm Springs Public Service District & Town of Bath reserve the right to reject any and all bids.
