TOWN OF NUTTER FORT HARRISON COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA NUTTER FORT AMD STORMWATER PHASE II

General Notice

Town of Nutter Fort (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Nutter Fort AMD Stormwater Phase II T20-11074

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the **Town of Nutter Fort** located at **1415 Buckhannon Pike, Nutter Fort, WV 26301**, until **Thursday, September 10, 2026 at 2:00 pm** local time. At that time the Bids received will be **publicly** opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

Dewatering of Pitcairn mine via horizontal bore and curtain drains. Bores are 12" fused HDPE pipe and may total 2,900' if all proposed bores are deemed necessary. Curtain drains are approximately 1,250 LF of 12" PVC. Installation of a stormwater conveyance system that includes new installation and removal and replacement of existing stormwater system features. Stormwater system includes approximately 6,400 LF of 12" - 72" pipe, lining of two (2) existing culverts, concrete inlets, manholes, and wingwalls, tie-ins, utility relocations of water and sewer lines, Arbutus Park Drive slope stabilization, trench repairs, and surface restorations.

Bids are requested for the following Contract: **Nutter Fort AMD Stormwater Phase II**

The Work will be substantially completed within 340 calendar days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run, and completed and ready for final payment within 400 days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run. Liquidated damages shall be \$1,000 per day.

A two envelope system will be used.

Envelope No. 1 must have the following information presented on the front:

Name and address of Bidder
Bid on Contract – Nutter Fort AMD Stormwater Phase II
Received by the Town of Nutter Fort

Envelope No. 2 labeled “Bid Proposal” shall also be placed inside of Envelope #1.

Envelope No. 1 will be opened first and the Bid Opening Requirement items checked for compliance as outlined on the Bid Opening Checklist on page BOR - 1 of these contract documents. If such documents are found to be in order, Envelope No. 2 “Bid Proposal”, will then be opened and will be publicly read aloud. If the documents required to be contained in Envelope No. 1 are not in order, Envelope No. 2 “Bid Proposal” will not be opened and the Bid will be considered non-responsive and will be returned to the Bidder.

A bidder may not withdraw his bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date set for the opening of bids.

Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to Town of Nutter Fort in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the base bid.

Notice of Federal Wage Requirements – Contractors are required to comply with all laws pertaining to federal wage rates as issued in accordance with the Davis Bacon Act. The contractor will be required to pay the federal wage rates appropriate for each worker classification.

Nondiscrimination in Employment – Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order Number 11246 and the provisions of Executive Order No. 10925 as included therein. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the specifications.

Suspension and Debarment – Recipient shall not entertain the use of businesses that are listed on the “System for Award Management” (SAM) at www.Sam.gov in accordance with 2 CFR Part 1532 and Subpart B and C of 2 CFR Part 180.

DBE Requirements – Each Bidder must fully Comply with the Disadvantaged Business Enterprises, and Affirmative Action Requirements, as identified in the contract documents.

Applicant Violator System (AVS) – Bidder must complete the Contractor Information Form (AVS) to request an eligibility evaluation from the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (<https://www.osmre.gov/programs/regulating-coal-mines/avs>). This requirement applies to Contractors and their Sub-contractors and is found under OSMRE’s regulations at CFR Title 30, Chapter VII, Subchapter R, Part 874.16: <https://www.ecfr.gov/current/title-30/chapter-VII/subchapter-R/part-874> Bidders should submit the most recent version with their bid documents. Form must be signed and dated within the last 30 days for Bid to be considered for any current solicitation.

Prospective Bidders should note that this Contract will include the following critical requirements as identified in the Contract Documents.

1. Affirmative Action Program Requirements and Goals
2. Certificate of Non-Segregated Facilities
3. Specific Labor Standard Provisions
4. WV Contract Licensing Act – All bidders are required to have a WV Contractor’s License per Section 30-42-12 of the WV Code.
5. WV Alcohol and Drug Free Workplace Act
6. Executive Order No. 10925, Build America, Buy America
7. Any other requirements deemed critical.

Build America, Buy America – This project is subject to the Build America, Buy America Act (BABAA) requirements under Title IX of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), Pub. L. 117-58, §§ 70901-70953. Absent an approved waiver, all iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used in this project must be produced in the United States.

Drug Free Workplace – West Virginia Code 21-1D-5 provides that any solicitation for a public improvement construction contract requires each vendor that submits a bid for the work to submit at the same time an affidavit of compliance with the bid. The enclosed drug-free workplace affidavit must be signed and submitted in the first envelope as evidence of the vendor's compliance with the provisions of Article 1D, Chapter 21 of the West Virginia code. Failure to submit the signed drug-free workplace affidavit in the first envelope shall result in disqualification of such bid.

Prospective Bidders are advised that the contracts awarded under this bid are to be funded in whole or in part by Town of Nutter Fort and the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection - Office of Abandoned Mine Lands (AML) Program.

All Bidders are required to have a West Virginia Contractor's License per Section §30-42-12 of the West Virginia Code.

Bids received after the scheduled closing time for the reception of bids will be returned unopened to the bidders. Bids received by Contractors that did not attend the Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be returned unopened to the Bidders.

The Town of Nutter Fort reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Pre-bid Conference

A **mandatory** pre-bid conference for the Project will be held on **Thursday, August 20, 2026 at 10:00 am** at the **Town of Nutter Fort, 1415 Buckhannon Pike, Nutter Fort, WV 26301**. Bids will not be accepted from Bidders that do not attend the mandatory pre-bid conference.
